




A Legacy of Conservation

Towards the end of his career, FMH founder W.A. Rutledge often reflected on the impact of converting areas like wetlands to farmland.

In 1993, in honor of the centennial celebration and W.A.'s conservation inclinations, FMH raised funds to purchase land outside of Early, Iowa - where W.A. had been raised - to return the land to its original wetland state. The area, called Burrow's Pond, remains a protected wetland to this day.

- Purchasing items that are ECOLOGO certified.










Going Paperless




FMH supports physical and emotional wellbeing with benefits such as enhanced mental health support, flexible work schedules, paternal and caregiver leave, and a generous time off policy.

Personal & Professional Development


In addition to employee training opportunities, FMH provides tuition reimbursement, continuing education and certification programs, and leadership development programs.
