

INSURED REPLANT CLAIM CHECKLIST



Contact your FMH agent immediately if you think you might have a replant claim. To prepare for your adjuster appointment, use this checklist to organize your records and speed up the claim adjustment process.

BEFORE REPLANTING OR DESTROYING A CROP

- Notice must be given to your agent before replanting.
- > The insured must speak to an adjuster before replanting.
- Any crop being destroyed must be appraised by an adjuster before destruction.

QUALIFICATIONS

- > MPCI (Federal Policy): Replants require at least 20 acres per unit or 20% of the unit EU, BU or OU to qualify for a replant payment. EIEU (irrigated) qualify by separate practice.
- Replant Premier (FMH Private Product):
 Replant Premier does not require a minimum number of acres to qualify.

PAYMENTS

- > A replant payment may be made only once on acreage and only for the same crop.
- The maximum replant payment will be limited as stated in the policy provisions.
- Acreage reports must be submitted to your agent and processed into the system before your claim can be finalized for payment.

RECORDS TO PROVIDE

- > If you can map your replant acres, please provide the map, which will be useful in recording acres, date, and what parts of the field were replanted.
- Dunless the replanted acreage is visually verified, a certification form must be completed and returned to your adjuster.
- > If your replant does not qualify for self-certification, it will need to be appraised, and the appraisal must be less than 90% of your guarantee to qualify.

SELF-CERTIFICATION

- > The Self-Certification Replant Worksheet may be used when the acreage to be replanted is 100 acres or less for the underlying database within the unit.
- A map is required for self-certification replants. These maps can come from FMS, FSA or they can be hand drawn.
- > For self-certification replants, a seed receipt is required unless you submit your acres through FMH Precision Solutions processes.
