


# Transferring Raw Data via the FMH Policy Holder Center

Updated March 2023

## Importing Raw Data to the Policy Holder Center

- A. Select the **Precision Solutions** Drop down located on the left side of the screen and select **Precision Data**



### Process to Upload Data

**Note:** In the event we need to request raw data, instructions to upload data and upload the correct file type are listed on the right side of the page. The process for uploading is listed below.

- a. Select **file type Planting/Harvest**
- b. Select the **Source Monitor** used (Case, Precision Planting, Trimble, other, etc.)
- c. Add any notes in the notes section for the file.
- d. Drag raw data folder to the select files box or select “Choose A File” to search through your computer and select file.
- e. Select **Submit** when finished

IMPORTANT: Do not leave this page or close your browser. Uploading your precision data file can take several minutes, depending on internet connection and the size of your file. If you leave the page or lose internet connection, please re-upload the data file using the instructions provided.

**Instructions**

- Select File Type for Planting, Harvest, or Other (boundary files).
- Select Source Monitor. If Other, please enter Source Monitor not listed.
- Enter additional notes or comments (optional).
- In order to upload the raw data file, you will need to zip the file for the monitor before sending to FMH.
  - For Windows:
    - Right click on the precision data file(s).
    - Select 'Send to'.
    - Select 'Compressed (zipped) folder'.
    - This will create a duplicate zipped folder within the same file location. The file icon will show a 'zipper', as indicated below.
  - For Mac:
    - Right click on the precision data file(s).
    - Select 'Compress'.
    - If a single file is being zipped, the file will remain the same name with a .zip extension
    - If multiple files are being zipped, the file will be named Archive.zip
    - This will create a duplicate zipped folder within the same file location. The file icon will show a 'zipper', as indicated below.

• Click on 'Choose a file' to select the zipped data file; or click and drag the zipped file over 'Choose a file' to upload.

**Note:** Some monitors will require a 32 GB flash drive to transfer data from the precision monitor in the tractor or combine. Example: Gen 4 John Deere and certain Case IH monitors.
