NO COVERAGE FOR NON-HIGHWAY VEHICLES OPERATED ON PUBLIC STREETS, HIGHWAYS, OR ROADWAYS ILLINOIS

The Commercial Liability Coverage of this policy is amended by the following. All other "terms" of the policy apply, except as amended by this endorsement.

DEFINITIONS

The following is added:

"Non-highway vehicle" means a "motorized vehicle" that is a non-highway vehicle as defined by Section 11-1426.1 of the Illinois Vehicle Code, including any amendments.

SUPPLEMENTAL COVERAGES

INCIDENTAL VEHICLE COVERAGE

The following is added to item 2. under Incidental Vehicle Coverage:

However, "we" do not pay for the "bodily injury" or "property damage" which arises out of a "non-highway vehicle" being operated on a public street, highway, or roadway located in the State of Illinois. This does not apply to a "non-highway vehicle" that, at the time of the "occurrence", is making a direct crossing of a street, highway, or roadway as permitted by Section 11-1426(b) or Section 11-1428(b) of the Illinois Vehicle Code.
